- **4. SETTLEMENT:** Buyer and Seller acknowledge that Seller must accomplish TOPA Compliance prior to the Settlement Date. If Settlement does not occur on the Settlement Date due to Seller not having accomplished TOPA Compliance, and Seller is not in Default, then the Settlement Date shall automatically be extended to the date which is the third Business Day following the date Seller accomplishes TOPA Compliance, unless otherwise agreed by Buyer and Seller. Buyer and Seller further agree that Buyer's obligation to complete Settlement **X** IS or **IS NOT (choose one)** contingent upon Seller delivering the Property vacant and free of tenancies at Settlement.
- **5. BUYER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:** Buyer acknowledges that as an owner of rental property in the District of Columbia there are a number of legal issues/requirements they, as an owner should be aware of, including but not limited to: rental registration requirements, landlord/tenant rights and obligations, business license requirements, rent control, tenant opportunity to purchase and right of first refusal, the District's opportunity to purchase (5 or more units), and the eviction process. Buyer is advised to consult the District of Columbia and/or obtain legal counsel regarding such matters.
